4. Consolidated Planning Grant (CPG) Funds for FFY 2021

Action Requested: Update: Discussion

*John Adams said that the MPO has quite of bit of carry over for the past few
years. He would like some input on use of the funds. Ben Valdez asked if that*

was planning or design, John said yes, and would need further discussion if some of those funds can go towards new Transit building. Cheryl Spinuzzi asked how much carry over there is, John said about \$880k.

**5. Featured Mode of Transportation:
Airport Master Plan – Greg Pedroza**

Action Requested: Informational

Ryan Hayes has a presentation for the Airport Master Plan, he explains that the study is to guide orderly development of future airport facilities, use FAA (Federal Aviation Administration) tools for planning and programming purposes, informs follow-on NEPA documents and City/County Land Use Planning, flexibility, and to coordinate with other studies (i.e. – LRTP). This study delivers a tangible narrative report (FAA approved forecasts, capital improvement plan, and implementation strategy), and FAA approved ALP (Airport Layout Plan). The Plan is to review and refine strategic goals and objectives, appropriate public/stakeholder coordination, forecasts/air service analysis, airfield capacity analysis, terminal building analysis, on airport land use development, redevelopment, and revenue enhancement analysis, and financial implementation analysis. They are in the very early planning process, COVID 19 has delayed them at least 4 months. Greg Pedroza said that Doss Aviation (Air Force 1 Military) is the main user. He said that they can use those numbers in the study. UAV is probably not included.

6. CDOT 1601 Policy Directive – Interchanges – Aaron Willis (CDOT)

Action Requested: Informational

Aaron Willis said that 1601 Policy is called CDOT's Interchange Approval. The policy is to guide principals and necessary steps to approve new interchanges or modify interchanges (interstate, freeway, state highway system). In his presentation, Aaron talked about the different types of interchange improvements, policy changes, Transportation Demand Management (TDM), and the scoring range.

Joe Garcia asked who is responsible for these in Pueblo, Aaron Willis said that this applies to the local agencies and is a requirement.

7. CDOT Region 2 and HQ Updates - Wendy Pettit and Aaron Willis

Wendy Pettit did not have any updates.

Aaron Willis said that there is more information on CPG (Consolidated Planning Grant) on CDOT's website. Emma Belmont said that there is an urgency on these funds.
