

TEEN AND UNINTENDED PREGNANCY

Action Plan

- Increase Access to Care
 - Host focus groups in order to identify barriers and solutions to accessing medical care and access to health and reproductive health information
 - At least three of the solutions identified will be implemented in order to reduce barriers to care
 - Conduct a community outreach campaign to increase awareness of resources and reproductive health care options
 - Implement Community Health Worker model at DSS

- Positive Youth Development (PYD)
 - Agencies working on positive youth development will purposefully collaborate in order to reduce duplication and maximize resources and impact
 - Support and promote participation in PYD activities
 - Host youth nights (i.e. trivia, karaoke, etc.)
 - Explore and promote internship and employment opportunities for youth 14-24

- Evidence-based Programs
 - Assist and promote the use of mentors with teens and youth
 - Assist and promote the use of parenting programs to improve skills

- Implement Comprehensive Sexual Health Education
 - Assist school districts with meeting Colorado Department of Education health standards and HB 1292 sexual health education requirements through training, parent coalitions, etc.
