

PROPERTY TAX WORK-OFF PROGRAM (PTWOP) APPLICATION PROCESS

2010 Applications

A Public Notice will be placed in the Pueblo Chieftain newspaper, December 2009, to announce the **2010 Property Tax Work-Off Program**. You will be notified of the date, time and location of the Property Tax Work-Off Program availability and acceptance of **application packets**.

Eligibility

An eligible taxpayer, as defined in Section 39-3.7-102 C.R.S., at the time of application is defined as any Pueblo County resident who is:

- Sixty years of age or older; or
- **Person with a Disability** - which means any individual with a physical impairment, a developmental disability as defined in section 27-10.5-102 (11) (a), C.R.S. or mental retardation that substantially limits one or more of the major life activities of the individual.
- The sole or joint owner of the property on which the property taxes are due, said property must be the owner-occupied residence of the taxpayer, or owner-occupied units in a condominium, townhouse, or similar structure; and
- The property on which the property taxes are due and owing is not income producing.

Acceptance of your completed application packet **does not guarantee** participation in the program. Program participation is based on **eligibility, background check and first come first serve. Funding is limited.**

When completing an application packet you must submit the following:

- ◆ Drivers License/Colorado ID issued by the Colorado Department of Revenue
- ◆ Social Security Card

Disabled applicants must include:

A **signed** and **dated letter** from a **Colorado Licensed Health Care Professional** verifying the applicant's disability

The PTWOP staff will notify applicants by telephone of their participation in the program.
