SHPO Response

The SHPO has reviewed the revised Area of Potential Effects and Determinations of Eligibility and Effects submitted for the project referenced above. I am attaching a copy of their response for your files. The SHPO has agreed with our revised APE and concurred with our finding of *no adverse effect* regarding the impacts to 5PE1776.12, 5PE1776.13, 5PE1776.14, 5PE6891.1, 5PE1665.12. They also agreed with our finding of no historic properties affected with regard to resource 5PE6891 and 5PE6895.

Consulting Parties Response

The City of Pueblo Historic Preservation Commission was given the opportunity to comment on the proposed project. They responded to our initial information on the Area of Potential Effects, however, we did not receive any response from them regarding any of our eligibility and effects correspondence.
