## Increase Fees for Food License

PUEBLO – Public health reported, Colorado state legislature increased the retail food establishment license fees throughout Colorado with House Bill 16-1401. This will be implemented over the next three years beginning September 2016.

“Food safety is important to the Pueblo City-County Health Department. The fees charged by health departments are set by the state legislature. An increase in the fees has been adopted by the state legislature House Bill 16-1401,” stated Sylvia Proud, public health director at the Pueblo City-County Health Department.

Below are the future fee increases for retail food establishments in Pueblo County, which will be implemented upon license renewal. All new licenses after September 1, 2016, will pay the new 2017 fees.
