## Additional Sites with Dumpsters to Dispose Food Affected During Beulah Hill Fire

Beulah residents may dispose only food waste at five locations Friday, October 7 through Sunday, October 9, 2016.

- Mountain Shadows Mobile Home Estates, 8080 Hwy 78
- Red Mountain Youth Camp, 4632 North Creek Road
- Pine Drive and Central Avenue (“Y” in road)
- Pine Drive and Pueblo Mountain Park Drive (Entrance to Pueblo Mountain Park)
- Beulah Post Office, 8867 Grand Avenue

Dumpsters for disposal of only food will be available from **10:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.** Dumpsters will be locked during non-operation hours.

Do not leave food waste on the ground or around the dumpster if it is locked, due to wildlife. According to Colorado Parks and Wildlife it is illegal to knowingly feed wild animals and can be met with fines. Take the trash home, store in a secure place and return the waste during hours of operation.

All other items affected (household trash, clothing, etc.) should remain on your property at this time. For disposal of household items, seek advice from insurance providers.
