Pueblo city and county residents may drop-off their real Christmas trees at no cost thru, **January 18** at **Rockworxs Inc.** located at 195 N. Vision Lane off East 4th Street, **between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, weather permitting.** The site is closed Saturday and Sundays.

Remove all decorations, tree stands, wires or nails from trees. No wreaths or garlands can be accepted due to the final chipping process.
