Pueblo’s Free Christmas Tree Recycling Drop-off starts January 4, 2017

Pueblo city and county residents may drop-off their cut Christmas trees at no cost beginning **Wednesday, January 4 through Saturday, January 14** at **Vision Recycled Aggregate** located at 195 Vision Lane off of East 4th Street, **between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Monday through Saturday**. The site is closed on Sundays.

Remove all decorations, tree stands, wires or nails from trees. No wreaths or garlands can be accepted due to the final chipping process. Free chips/mulch will be available to the public **after 12 p.m. on Monday, January 16** on a first come, first served basis. Cash donations are welcome for both drop-off and mulch pick-up.
