Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day

Pueblo’s **Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day** is planned for **Saturday, May 14 from 8:00am to 1:00pm** at the **Colorado State Fair Grounds (Gate 3)**. This event is open to all residents in the City and County of Pueblo with ID. Participants enter the event from the westbound lane of Mesa Avenue only. No waste will be accepted from businesses, schools or large facilities.

Households may drop-off chemicals, poisons, fertilizers, cleaners, mercury-containing devices such as fluorescent bulbs, thermometers and thermostats, latex and oil paints and stains, vehicle and household batteries, and scrap appliances free of charge. Appliances containing Freon such as refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners can be dropped off for a \$5 fee per item. Used passenger tires may also be dropped off for a \$1 fee per tire, with a limit of 12 tires. Electronic waste (computers and TVs) is accepted for a fee, upwards of \$10 each, depending on size and weight. Payment on event day must be in cash or check.

No motor oil, filters, antifreeze, bio-medical waste, drugs, ammunition, compressed gas tanks, or household trash will be allowed.

Proper disposal and recycling of waste can prevent water and land pollution, and avoid excessive landfilling. The Pueblo City-County Health Department hosts this event with support from the City of Pueblo, Pueblo Stormwater Utility, Pueblo Wastewater Department and Pueblo County. Participants are encouraged to carpool by bringing other family or neighbor’s items. Information for recycling and disposal year round is available at www.pueblohealthdept.org/recycleinfo.
