Eastside Neighborhood Clean-Up Saturday, May 28, 2016

The annual Eastside Neighborhood Clean-up will be held Saturday, May 28, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the parking lot of St. Leander's Church at 7th Street and Monument Avenue.

Participants must pre-purchase tickets to dispose of waste at the clean-up. Tickets for a level pick-up truck load are \$15 each, with a limit of two per household. A limited number of seniors (65 years+) and disabled residents, without any means of delivery, may request curbside pick-up assistance with ID by signing up when tickets are purchased by Thursday, May 28. Tickets are on sale now at the following locations:

Residents may dispose of tree and shrub trimmings, cut 6 feet or less, old scrap appliances, passenger tires (extra \$2 per tire - limit 12 tires), scrap lumber, mattresses, old furniture and fencing. Yard waste, such as leaves, weeds, and cut grass must be bagged. Items not accepted are bagged house garbage, hazardous waste or liquids, TVs, computers, refrigerators, freezers or air conditioners.

This event is hosted by the Pueblo City-County Health Department. Call the Health Department's Environmental Coordinator Program at 583-4924 for event information or to volunteer. Parents must accompany volunteers under 18 years old.
