The dog may have had contact with other animals or people in the neighborhood.

Contact the Pueblo Department of Public Health & Environment at (719) 583-4307 immediately if you or your pets have had contact with this dog.

To protect yourself and family, take the following precautions:

1) Vaccinate your pets for rabies.

Pet dogs & cats must be up-to-date on rabies vaccinations through your local veterinarian. Pets must be wearing current license tags on their collar. For information on rabies vaccination for your pets, please call your local veterinarian or Pueblo Animal Services at (719) 544-3005.

2) Keep pets on a leash when outside a fenced yard.

If your pet has contact with a skunk, rabies, or other wild animal, please report this to local animal control.

3) Enjoy wildlife from a distance.

Do NOT attempt to feed, approach, or touch wild animals. If you see a wild mammal acting abnormally (rabid animals may show no fear of people and may even seem friendly) in this area, report it to local animal control at (719) 544-3005.
