4. CDOT Region II TIP/STIP Consent Notifications

CDOT did not have any policy amendments for the month of May.

5. CDOT Region II TIP/STIP Administrative Notification

CDOT Region II gave notification of one administrative amendment to the PACOG Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) in the MPO/TPR area.

Mr. Scott Hobson briefly reported the amendment, there was no further discussion.

6. *Bike Month Activities – Kim Arline P.A.C.E.*

Ms. Kim Arline discussed community bike activities for the months of May and June. Ms. Arline stated every Thursday beginning May 2 through October 31 there will be a Cruisin' Pueblo casual Thursday night rides from Bingo Burger at 6 pm. She reported research she has conducted regarding local bike racks in the City and Pueblo West. 226 bike racks were counted and expressed a need for 93 more within the City and 34 in Pueblo West. The cost for a basic "U" shape bike rack is about \$50 plus the decorative feature required in the City by the newly adopted Streetscape Standards which can be up to an extra \$100 in cost.

7. *Amendments to Chapter 1 – Introduction and Plan Overview; and Chapter 9 – Fiscally Constrained Plan of the Approved 2035 Long Range Transportation Plan*

Mr. Scott Hobson presented the TAC with the proposed text amendment to the 2035 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). The change is solely to reflect revenue projections and account for economical forecasting regarding funds to pay for approved capital projects in this region. A draft resolution was presented to the TAC to move the text amendment forward to the PACOG Board for approval on May 23.

8. *Review of the PACOG Recommended Responsible Acceleration of Maintenance and Partnerships Program (RAMP) Projects List*

Mr. Hobson reported to the TAC that three RAMP pre-applications were submitted for consideration to CDOT. Of the three applications, two were I-25 projects; one from ILEX to 13th Street at a cost of \$119 Million and the other from 13th Street to 29th at a cost of \$116 Million. The I-25 projects are broken down into three separate segments that may be funded individually. The third application was submitted for US 50 to add a third lane between Pueblo Blvd (SH 45) to Purcell at a cost of \$30.4 Million. In order to provide matching contribution to the I-25 projects 23 acres of City owned right of way (ROW) is being offered as well as the possibility of a devolution process to take over current CDOT highways in exchange for the US 50 project.

Kristen Castor discussed a sidewalk study created by CSU-Pueblo which was requested to be distributed to members digitally after the meeting adjourned.
