WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Children 3 to 4 years of age, families who want to bridge the gap to prepare their child for kindergarten (Services available in Spanish)

WHAT IS IT?

Provides books and materials to prepare the child for success in school, promotes school readiness, and early literacy with parent involvement.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Any woman who is pregnant with her first child, meets income requirements, and lives in the service area
Enroll as early as possible during your pregnancy

WHAT IS IT?

Provides a registered nurse that will visit you in your home throughout pregnancy and until your child is two years old to help you have a healthy pregnancy, healthy baby, and become a better parent.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Birth to 5 years of age, parents looking for extra support to keep their families safe and healthy
(Services available in Spanish)

WHAT IS IT?

Provides weekly home visits with direct skill training and resources for parents. Families receive support managing child behavior, keeping their home free of safety hazards, and taking care of their child's basic health care needs.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Any family in Pueblo County with a child prenatal to three years of age
(Services available in Spanish)

WHAT IS IT?

Provides home visits for families with children 0 to 3 years of age. Families receive early childhood education to promote the parent's role as their child's first and most important teacher as well as health records, developmental screenings, and various resources.
