## Funding Available for Agencies Serving Victims of Crime

The Victim Assistance and Law Enforcement (VALE) Board of the Tenth Judicial District (Pueblo County) is accepting agency applications for 2022 funding to support victim services. Funds for the grants are generated by fines assessed by the courts. The Local VALE Board anticipates allocating approximately \$300,000 to organizations and programs providing services to Pueblo County crime victims.

There will be a mandatory Applicant's Workshop on Wednesday, September 13, 2021, from 11:30 am - 2:00 pm for agencies interested in applying for the VALE grant. This training will be held at the District Attorney's Community Conference Room, 701 Court Street. It offers an opportunity for grant applicants to learn about the VALE fund and to ask questions about the application process, and training to better understand the roles and responsibilities executive directors and boards for non-profit organizations. RSVP is required to attend.

Grant application forms and instructions may be obtained from the local VALE Administrator, Hope Martinez, by email or at the District Attorney's Office, 701 Court Street in Pueblo. Completed applications must be received by to the DA's office no later than October 11, 2021 at 4:00 PM. Late applications will not be accepted.
