

Pre-Cleaning Procedures for Vomit/Fecal Events

1. Identify spill site.
2. Close off foot traffic within a 5-foot radius.
3. Remove single-use body fluid spill kit from the plastic case and set aside.
4. Empty all contents of the spill kit on a flat surface just outside of the spill site.
5. Locate the package of personal protective equipment (PPE).
 - a. Place shoe covers over shoes.
 - b. Put protective gown over your head, placing your thumbs through loops.
 - c. Affix the facemask using ear loops.
 - d. Place the hair cover on your head.
 - e. Put on non-latex gloves, then pull over the gown sleeves.
6. Place one of the black plastic bags near the spill site.
7. Remove cap and seal from the disinfectant being used.
8. Attach trigger sprayer.

Cleaning Procedures for Vomit/Fecal Events

1. Saturate spill site and surrounding area with disinfectant being used. The amount of product used may vary depending on the brand or type. Follow manufacturer's guidelines.
2. Let the product sit. Wait time may vary per product, follow manufacturer's guidelines. Then proceed to next step.
3. Sprinkle absorbent powder over spill site. Start along the outside edge and work towards the center of spill.
4. Discard bottle and let the product sit, time may vary per product, refer to manufacturer's guidelines. Proceed to next step.
5. Retrieve the scraper and dustpan.
6. Use scraper to push solid matter into dustpan and discard into the trash bag until all the solid matter has been removed.
7. Discard the scraper and dustpan into trash bag.
8. Respray affected area with the disinfectant being used.
9. Let the product sit, time may vary per product, refer to manufacturer's guideline. Then proceed to next step.
10. If spill splatter is present, spray disinfectant being used on towels and wipe clean. Be sure to check vertical surfaces.
11. Spray or pour ALL remaining disinfectant being used of the original spill site.
12. Discard the bottle and let air-dry.
13. Discard all remaining spill kit contents.
14. Tie and place first black trash bag into second bag.
15. Discard of all remaining spill kit contents.
16. Discard personal protective equipment (PPE).
 - a. Remove shoe covers and dispose.
 - b. Remove facemask and hair cover.
 - c. Grasp gown with both hands and pull away from body, breaking the neck loop and back loop. Use inside sleeves to remove gloves without contacting the contaminated sides.
17. After placing all protective wear inside second bag, tie off and prepare to discard.
18. Dispose black plastic bags in an outside dumpster.
19. Use hand sanitizer.
20. Thoroughly wash hands for 20 seconds.
21. Once spill site is dry, reopen area to customers and employees.
