ABA, WHAT IS IT?

ABA Therapy is considered the "gold standard therapy" for helping people with developmental disorders gain new skills and reduce unsafe behaviors. NTSOC's ABA therapy branch is provided in-home or in the community, based on the needs of your child. ABA interventions often look different for each child, as each person's skill goals are highly individualized. Such interventions focus on identifying the reason why a person is engaging in unsafe behaviors and teaching the person to engage in alternative communications and adaptive skills through the use of strategic positive reinforcement.
