DIRECT INSTALL PROGRAM

Through your participation in the program, you may qualify for the installation of the following ENERGY STAR® certified equipment:

- Refrigerators
- Evaporative coolers (swamp coolers)
- LED light bulbs

- 3. Proof of the applicant's qualifying benefit(s), such as LEAP, TANF, WIC, OAP, AB, AND, SNAP, Medicaid, Section 8 housing OR one (1) full month of pay stubs for all employed members of the household.






Window Type

Evaporative coolers are mounted inside a window. To install an evaporative cooler in your home, you must have a window that meets the requirements. Approved windows slide open and have an opening that is 22" x 22" or larger when fully open.





Refrigerator Type

To install a refrigerator in your home, you must own one that meets the replacement requirements. You'll need to gather the serial number, manufacturer, and other details from the upper left side wall OR upper right side wall, inside of the main compartment.



Light Bulb Count

To install efficient light bulbs, you must be replacing inefficient incandescent bulbs. You'll need to count how many inefficient bulbs you have in your household. They are ones that have a filament inside or are not CFL/LED bulbs.
