## **Body Art Temporary Event Application**

Incomplete applications or applications without payment (if required), will not be processed.

All body art temporary events held in Pueblo County, Colorado that offer body art to the public must have a license and comply with the Pueblo Department of Public Health and Environment Body Art Regulation No. X.

Temporary Event: An industry trade show, convention, procedural/product demonstration, educational seminar, or other similar event at which body artists perform body art services and procedures outside of a permanent body art establishment approved by the Department. And that last no longer then fourteen (14) consecutive days.

Mobile Unit: An enclosed unit on wheels, and is readily moveable, which may only be used for the performance of body art services in conjunction with a temporary event approved the Department.

Event Coordinator: The person responsible for obtaining health department approval for a temporary event, and the person responsible for ensuring compliance with these regulations at temporary events.

Body	Art temporary event requirements
Body	artist are either:
	Affiliated with a body art establishment approved by the appropriate body art regulatory authority for their home jurisdiction; or
	Sponsored by the operator of a body art establishment approved in the jurisdiction of the Pueblo Department of Public Health and Environment, provided a written sponsorship agreement is submitted to the health department with the temporary event application. The operator-sponsor will be responsible for ensuring that the body artist understands the requirements of these regulations; and
	Body artists have complied with Section 2-201 of these regulations and are available at

Step	2 – Submit this application at least 30 days prior to proposed start date of temporary event

Infectious/regulated waste, other than sharps shall be placed in impervious, tear resistant, plastic bags, which are red in color and marked with the Universal Biological Hazard Symbol. Sharps and infectious/regulated waste shall be disposed of by an approved, off-site treatment facility in accordance with Pueblo Department of Public Health and Environment Body Art Regulation No X.
