Submitted proposals must be no more than 50 pages, document size no larger than 50MB and must be one (1) pdf document. Proposals received after the date and time listed above will not be considered. The date and time listed in the Outlook Inbox for the above-referenced email address will be the official date and time of when the electronically submitted proposal was received.

To be eligible to submit a proposal, all proposal documents must be obtained from the Pueblo County Purchasing Department via e-mail at purchasing@pueblocounty.us. Those wishing to obtain proposal document(s) directly from the office of the Pueblo County Purchasing Department, must first call (719) 583-6095 to schedule an appointment to do so.
