

RESOLUTION NO. 25-233

**THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF PUEBLO COUNTY, COLORADO**

**AMENDING LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSE REGULATIONS TO ELIMINATE DISTANCE
REQUIREMENTS BETWEEN THE LOCATION OF HOTEL AND RESTAURANT LIQUOR
LICENSES AND SCHOOLS**

WHEREAS, Article 3 of Title 44, C.R.S., Pueblo County governs the licensing of alcoholic beverages for the State of Colorado, and permits for local licensing to add, eliminate, or amend certain restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the local licensing authority for Pueblo County is the Board of County Commissioners, along with their delegated designees; and

WHEREAS, new applications for a liquor license are prohibited from locations within five hundred feet of any public or parochial school, or the principal campus of any college, university, or seminary, pursuant to C.R.S. § 44-3-313(1)(d)(I), with some exceptions; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of any county may, by resolution, eliminate or reduce distance requirements between any class of license and one or more type of school, pursuant to C.R.S. § 44-3-313(1)(d)(II); and

WHEREAS, the Board believes it would be beneficial to eliminate the distance requirements between the class of hotel and restaurant liquor licenses and all schools in the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pueblo County, Colorado, that the distance requirements between hotel and restaurant liquor licenses and all school types be eliminated pursuant to Article 3 of Title 44, C.R.S. Staff may now accept and process applications that otherwise would have been prohibited due to these distance requirements.
